Title: Joint Appeal Books and Transcript Extracts

Cite as: *Joint Appeal Books and Transcript Extracts (Civil Practice Directive, 19 September 2011)*

Parties wishing to file joint appeal books pursuant to Rule 26(3) and (4) and transcript extracts pursuant to Rule 27 may agree to file the appellant's factum, the respondent's factum, the joint appeal books and transcript extracts at the same time. This allows the parties to make proper references to the appeal book and transcript extracts in their factums. The parties must file their joint appeal books, transcript extracts and factums within 120 days of the appellant filing the appeal record. At the time of filing the appeal books, the parties must also file a consent order extending the time for filing the appeal books, transcript extracts and factums signed by all parties to the appeal.
