Practice Direction

Real Time Reporting

Summary:

Real time reporting is the contemporaneous transcription of proceedings. This Practice Direction sets out the procedures that must be following by counsel intending to use real time reporting.

Direction:

- 1. Counsel intending to use real time reporting of a civil trial must notify the Manager, Supreme Court Scheduling at the registry where the trial will be held in writing, 30 days in advance of the trial date.
- 2. Counsel using real time reporting will be responsible for all costs associated with the real time reporting.
- 3. A connection to the real time reporter's computer will be provided to the presiding judge during the proceedings.
- 4. A copy of any transcript prepared by the real time reporter must be provided to the presiding judge.
- 5. Only a reporter who qualifies as an authorized reporter under the Official Reporters' Regulation, *Court Rules Act*, may serve as a real time reporter in the courtroom.
